1. Several comments were received similar to the following: On the first spec, Quality Incentive Allowance, you need to add the word “be” after will.

Response: Agreed.

2. The first sentence below seems to imply that a quality incentive allowance is only applied if there is a price reduction. Consider revising the sentence to make it less ambiguous. Maybe change it to “Quality Incentive Allowances will be applied as a positive payment adjustment.”

Response: With the proposed rewording if the of the second paragraph in the above draft, the first sentence becomes unnecessary and can be deleted.
