


Discussion of Proposed Kagy Boulevard Reconstruction Project

The Montana Department of Transportation and the City of Bozeman, in cooperation with Montana State University (MSU), Museum of the Rockies and other stakeholders, have initiated a project for the reconstruction of Kagy Boulevard from S. 19th Avenue to Willson Avenue.

Anticipated improvements include roadway widening, intersection improvements, landscaping, and the installation of lighting, storm drains and pedestrian and bicycle facilities.

An open house and informational meeting will be held Thursday, April 21, in the Stadium Club, located on the third floor of the MSU Football Stadium (1 Bobcat Circle). Enter on the west side and take the elevator to the third floor.



The open house will run from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m., with a presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. The meeting will introduce the project and identify issues important to the community.
